#### • Tournament – Bob Kline

- o Mr Bass: 50 boats, 99 fishermen \$10,455 payout total. Anglers: \$6970 Co-Anglers: \$3485
- Two test east regional combined district tournaments have been run so far: April - 47 boats, May - 38 boats. The test format is showing increased numbers per tournament.
- o Team Regional tournaments: West 6, Central 6, East 18 teams − 30 teams
- o Total from tournaments is about \$6000 towards division team.

- Reminder that the team regional touraments are still the old boater/rider format, 4 hours fishing waters and trolling motor control for the rider.
- Possible tournament changes sheets handed out to be taken back to districts for discussions and further suggestions.
- o Tournament format changes to be proposed at the August meeting. All clubs are urged to show up to vote on changes.

- Lee Yingling 5 cases for central
- o Boaters are reminded they *must* provide seats for riders and the boat *must* be in good repair including kill switches, safety equipment and live wells etc.! There have been issues lately and we will be disqualifying boaters if we get protests at the tournaments.
- Motion is made to donate remainder of chatter baits to youth and charity fund raiser by Borderline. The state has already recouped the investment.
